"This is my DRAP plus 1 report. We now have fewer members, those of us left have been through a lot of changes; new teams, new managers and often inexperienced managers resulting in a lot of tension in the workplace. There has been in increase in the frequency we have been called to represent.

A reminder that our Collective Agreement is not subject to administrative decisions. It is important that we uphold our rights and not miss breaks, or work unpaid overtime. We care about our clients and the service we provide and the best way to do that is to show the full impact of the cutbacks and perhaps Canadian public will decide they want change.

Despite of this, the Local activity has expanded. Our website is up and running which members can sign up for e-mail notifications of new information and events. Lunch hour meetings have been well attended including two on bargaining. Your Executive, and steward, have attended training, represented members against the employer, and participated in PSAC conferences and meetings. Some have held additional offices in the PSAC outside the Local. Congratulations to Ruby for being elected National Aboriginal Representative to the Union of National Employees, Human Rights Committee.

The Program and Administrative Services, Collective Agreement expires on June 30, 2014. The Treasury Board submitted a notice to bargain to the PSAC on February 28,

2014. The government has been very open about their intentions, they are coming after our sick leave. Added to this, they are passing legislation making it harder for us to strike and operate as a union. Bills have been passed or on the horizon requiring unions to complete cumbersome paperwork, limit our ability to collect dues, and unilaterally decide essential service agreements limiting the amount of us who can strike. It will be a tough battle ahead if we don't want to go backwards.

To end, I would like to thank those who support us: the UNE National staff and Executive and our UNE Regional Team; also, our PSAC BC Regional Executive officers and PSAC BC staff."
