- 3. Report of the President, Theresa Marion:

Welcome to the 2015 Annual General Meeting of the PSAC, Union of National Employees Local 20150. It is my pleasure to report on our third year as a Local made up exclusively of AANDC employees.

We started the year with 273 members (as of January 1, 2014), and on December 31 there were 269 (232 full and 37 Rand). As of today, there are 286 members.

Throughout 2014, your local executive has been working hard to represent your interests in the larger PSAC and union movement, to represent members, and to educate ourselves and our members.

In August we were delegates to Union of National Employees Convention in Victoria and voted for Component President, the National Executive, and Sister Ruby was elected as UNE Aboriginal Equity Representative. We attended the PSAC-BC Triennial Conference in April here in Vancouver. We've also attended courses, conferences and meetings. We became affiliated with the Canadian Labour Congress, and attended the BC Federation of Labour conference where we elected a new President, Irene Lanzinger, who replaces outgoing president Jim Sinclair.

We hosted a bargaining information session for members with Tracy Cochrane, a member of the bargaining team, on February 17, 2015, and on June 19, 2014 with Robert Strang from PSAC-BC. We discussed and voted on bargaining demands in November 2013.

Joint Learning Program Workshops with union/management facilitators were held at AANDC: Duty To Accommodate, Creating a Harassment-Free Workplace, Respecting Differences and Anti-Discrimination, Understanding the Collective Agreement.
