- 3. Report of the President, Theresa Marion:

Welcome to the 2016 Annual General Meeting of the PSAC, Union of National Employees Local 20150. It is my pleasure to report on our fourth year as a Local made up exclusively of INAC employees.

The biggest news is, of course, the results of the October 19 election. We are very glad that we were able to Heave Steve. While we are still in the honeymoon phase of the new Liberal government, we cannot let our guard down. In fact, the shine is beginning to wear off a bit. Monica will be giving you an update on bargaining, and though it's not quite as dire as it was under the Conservatives, it doesn't sound like there is much cause for celebration...yet.

With the new government came a new departmental name, we are now Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada. Goodbye AANDC (antsy), hello INAC.

We started the year on January 1, 2015 with 269 members (232 full and 37 Rand), and as of October, the last date for which we got numbers from UNE we had 254 members, 219 full and 35 Rand. As of today, according to PSAC-BC, there are 279 members. We are having problems with keeping the list up to date. The department isn't reporting new members in a timely fashion, but we are doing our best when we know there are new members, we look up the membership list to see if they are listed, and if they aren't, we get them to sign a membership card, and send it in, so the UNE can sign them up and add them to the list.

Nine of our colleagues in Residential and Individual Affairs received affected letters on Nov 19. We were able to offer support for them, and organized a lunch-hour information session for Nov 24 where Monica Urrutia came to give a presentation with concrete information about potential options. Only today, I got notification that five of those members have now received opting letters on February 19. We offer them our support during this challenging time.

We said goodbye to three of our executive members. Tara French left to pursue her studies. Maggie Humen took a job with the RCMP in Surrey, and Emma Fleetham left to continue her university studies.

We hosted four Joint Learning Program courses right here in Leylum June 30 –Creating a Harassment-Free Workplace

July 16–Understanding the Collective Agreement July 23–Mental Health in the Workplace August 13–Duty to Accommodate
